

California Prop 65 Statement


Background

Effective from 30th August 2018, the State of California has required 'clear and reasonable warnings' in respect of the amounts of specific chemicals in the products which consumers purchase, use in their homes or workplaces, or that are released into the environment. The aim of which is to protect against exposure to chemicals known by the State of California to cause cancer, birth defects or reproductive harm. The list of substances of concern, and / or the concentration present above which notification for each substance is required (or 'safe harbor level'), being that published by the State and known as the California Prop-65 list.

Statement

Products placed on the market in the State of California by Cytiva are not intended for 'consumer' sale and are for professional or industrial use only. Therefore, the only anticipated exposure to these items would be through 'occupational exposure' which does not require mandatory labelling of all articles. Hence, based on anticipated use, Cytiva products placed on the market in the State of California don't expect any exposure to Prop 65 substances that would require a Prop 65 warning.
