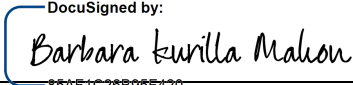
Halal

Kosher

Kosher refers to products permitted under Jewish dietary law. The responsible rabbinical authority certifies that ingredients, production, and packing comply with their religious requirements.

It is hereby stated that Cytiva's cell culture products are not intended to be used as food, as ingredients in food, or as direct components/constituents of ingredients used in food. They have not been certified Halal or Kosher and there is no plan to provide such certifications in the future.
