### Regarding: Dioxin in cell culture products

It is hereby stated that no known sources of dioxin are used as raw materials in or introduced during the manufacturing processes for Cytiva cell culture products.

Because they are not intended to be used as food, as ingredients in food, or as direct components/constituents of ingredients used in food, Cytiva's cell culture products do not fall under US, EU or international food contaminant regulations, such as Dioxin levels listed in the Annex of Commission Regulation (EU) No 1881/2006 setting maximum levels for certain contaminants in foodstuff, Section 5: Dioxins and PCBs.

Neither incoming raw materials nor finished products themselves are tested for the presence of dioxins.
