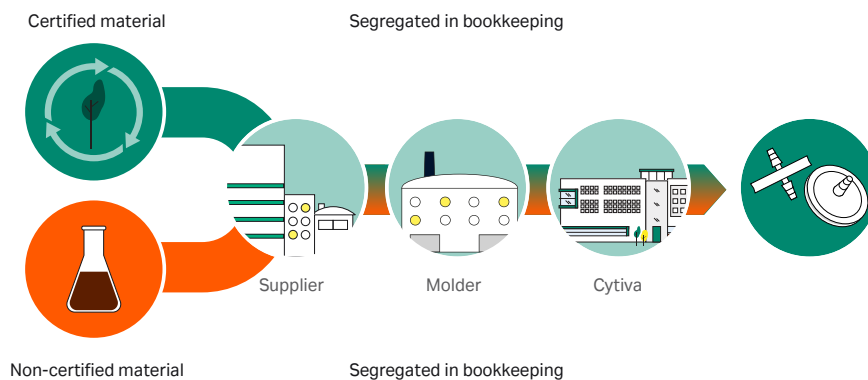
- Waste and residues from vegetable oil refining.
